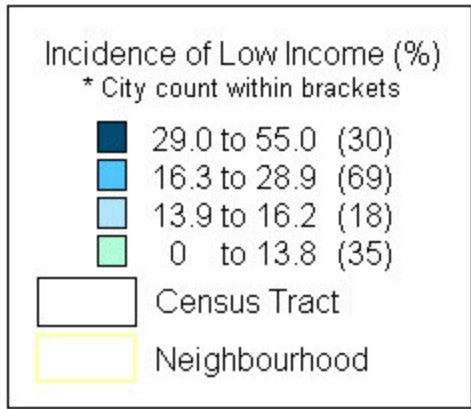


City Centre Edmonton Incidence of Low Income
