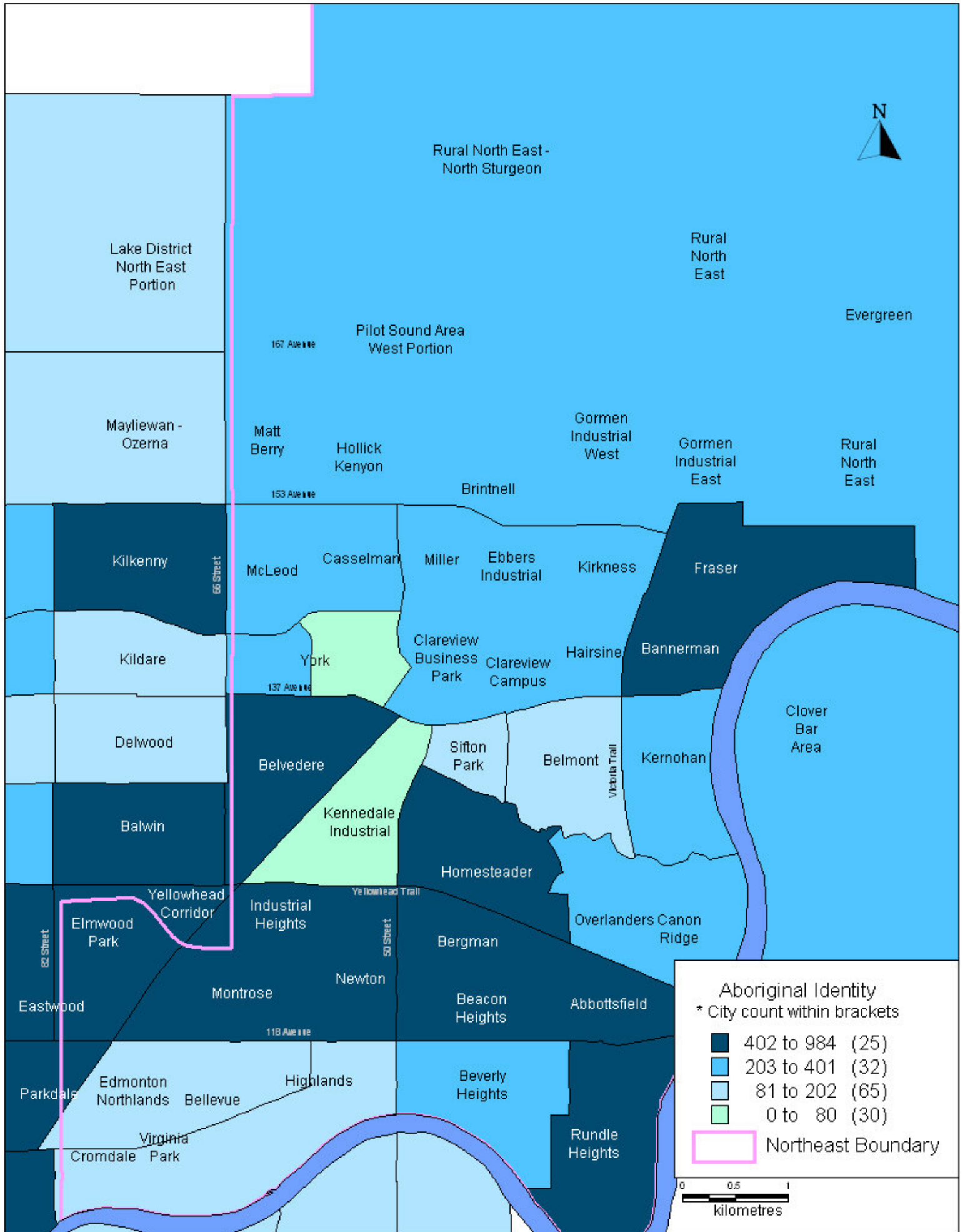


# Northeast Aboriginal Identity
