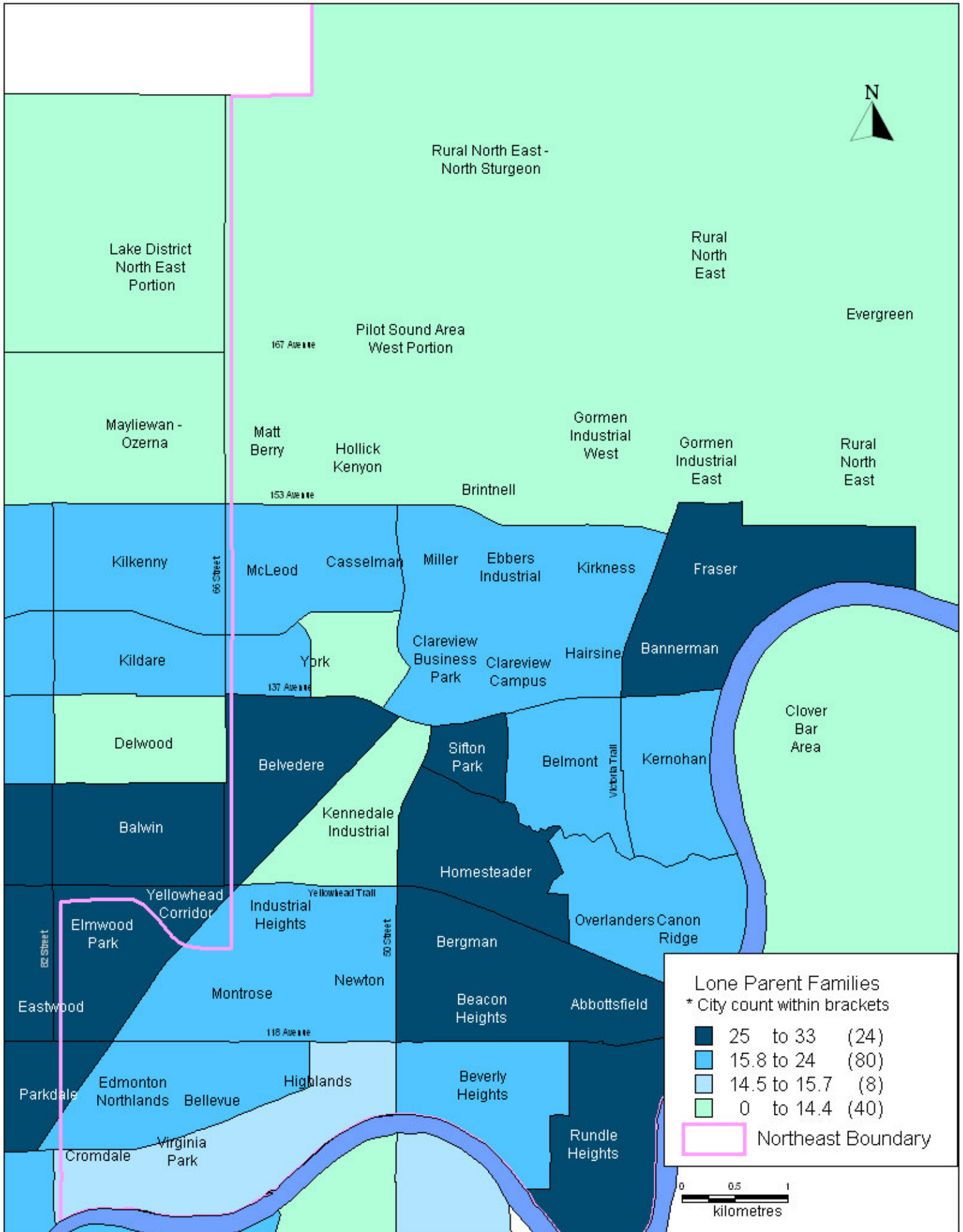


Northeast Proportion of Lone Parent Families
