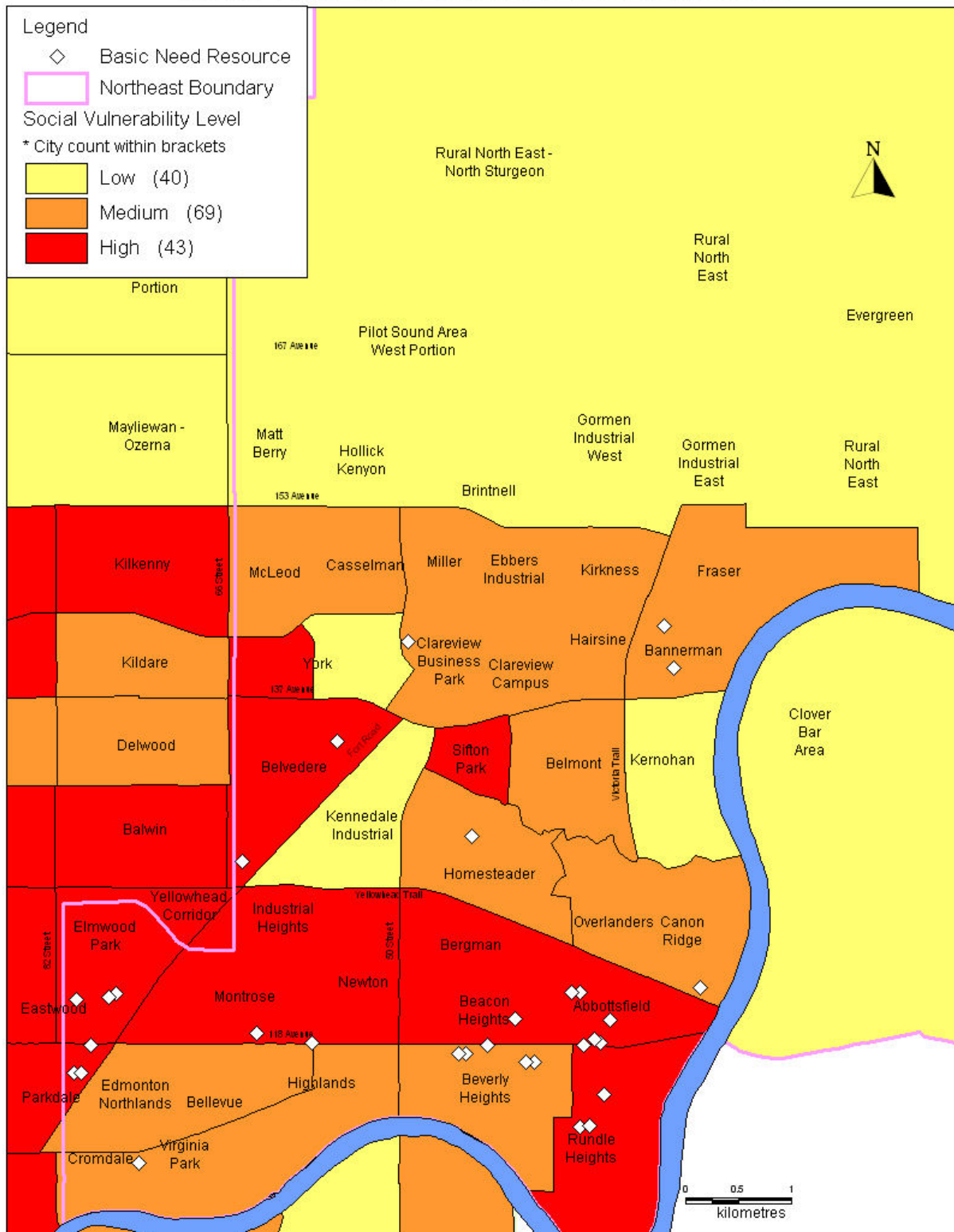


Northeast Social Vulnerability Levels with Basic Need Resources
